


What if my child doesn't understand?

Some teachers offer students a way to let the teacher know they are struggling with concepts without losing all credit for parts of an assignment. This option is only available on **daily** assignments. The options vary according to teacher (some require a specific form to be filled out while others require that the students write an explanation inline with the homework assignment in question). An example of the form some teachers require is provided below.

Students are not given extensions for long-term projects due to lack of understanding content or requirements. Students should ask for clarification long before the assignment is due. Most teachers at SGMS post the assignment and rubric in class in case students misplace their personal copies.
